“The Art of Auditioning”

Theatre professionals will show you how an audition works, how to build your confidence and how to go through the process successfully. Students will rotate through a series of three 45 min. sessions covering:

Cold Reading: Focus on how to read a script and to make character choices quickly. Discover the value of responding to other actors on

stage with you. Learn how to use your muscles and breath to support and project your voice.

Dance: Whether you consider yourself a great dancer or not, you can learn how to pick up moves quickly when auditioning for a musical. More importantly, you can show the choreographer your willingness to learn, and have fun while doing it.

Singing: Sing out, Louise! Learn proper voice techniques for the style of song you are singing, and how to “sell” your audition song.
